Environmental Quality Programs Specialist I or II

Under general supervision, conduct inspections of air emission sources and evaluates compliance with federal and state air quality regulations and permit conditions. Conduct observations of air emission performance tests and relative accuracy test audits at state and federally regulated facilities across the State of Nebraska. Other primary duties include preparing reports and documenting inspection observations including evaluating potential violations. Reviewing air emission performance test results and preparing reports related to the performance test results. Review draft permits, conduct file reviews, responds to complaints, assist the ambient air monitoring team and supports the Department facility database. Environmental Engineer I or Environmental Engineer II
