3. The deadlines for the filing of the second amended complaint and the State's motion for preliminary injunction, the responses thereto, and for the briefing of the motion for preliminary injunction and dispositive motions that the United States may file, are as follows:

September 21: State's second amended complaint;

September 28: State's motion for preliminary injunction;

October 26: United States' response to second amended complaint and response to motion for preliminary injunction (the United States' submissions may include a full or partial motion to dismiss and/or other dispositive motion(s));

November 26: State's reply in support of motion for preliminary injunction and opposition to United States' motion(s), if any;

December 17: United States' reply in support of its motion(s), if any.

4. If the second amended complaint includes one or more claims under the

Administrative Procedure Act "(APA") and the United States files a motion to dismiss one or more APA claims, then the deadlines in Local Rule 16.3 (Administrative Agency Appeals) are stayed during the pendency of the motion. If the motion to dismiss is denied, then the parties promptly shall confer and submit a proposed schedule to address any remaining APA claims.
