 - Nonattainment 2015 8-hr standard: Marginal



Permitting Thresholds

POLLUTANT	POTENTIAL TO EMIT (TPY)
PM _{2.5}	0.5
PM ₁₀	0.5
SO ₂	1.0
NO _X	1.0
VOC	0.5
CO	1.0
Pb	0.3
Single Hazardous Air Pollutants	0.5
Total Hazardous Air Pollutants	1.0
Any Other Regulated Pollutant	1.0



Regulatory Triggers: Type of Permit

- Title V (Major source permits)
 - Criteria Pollutants except PM₁₀: 100 tpy
 - PM₁₀: 70 tpy
 - HAPs: 10 tpy single and 25 tpy total
- Non Title V (Minor source permits)
 - Anything < Title V and above permitting threshold including Synthetic Minor permits
- General Permits
 - Similar sources and < Minor New Source Review threshold



Minor NSR Thresholds

POLLUTANT	POTENTIAL TO EMIT (TPY)
PM _{2.5}	5.0
PM ₁₀	7.5
SO ₂	20
SO ₂ NO _X VOC	20
VOC	20
CO	50
Pb	0.3

Regulatory Triggers: BACT Controls

POLLUTANT	POTENTIAL TO EMIT (TPY)
PM _{2.5}	10
PM ₁₀	15
SO ₂	40
NO _X	40
VOC	40
CO	100
Pb	0.3
	*Note: All permitted sources below the thresholds above are subject to RACT



Public Participation

- All applications are listed on the website for 30 days.
- 30-day Public Notice in newspapers and website for two weeks for certain permits.
- Depends on PTE of new permit or modification.
- EPA 30-day review of Synthetic Minor permits
- List of permits issued posted monthly on website.
