# **EPA Compilation of Links to Data Used for Proposed CSAPR Updates**

#### **December 16, 2015**

On Monday, December 14, 2015, NACAA held a conference call to discuss EPA's proposed updates to the Cross-State Air Pollution Rule to address the 2008 ozone NAAQS. EPA staff joined NACAA members for the first hour of the call to answer questions, many of which related to data used by EPA to develop the proposal. ## EPA's base case power sector modeling

## **EPA's EGU NOx reduction potential modeling**

Note: EPA did not create parsed files in the post-processing of these model runs.

- \$1,300 uniform cost threshold assessment (used for the proposed emissions budgets)
  Links to the <u>state-level emissions</u> and Link to the <u>system summary report</u>
  Link to the <u>detailed model run data</u>, including model plant-level data in the RPE file\*
- \$500 uniform cost threshold assessment (used for the less-stringent alternative) Links to the <u>state-level emissions</u> and Link to the <u>system summary report</u>
- \$3,400 uniform cost threshold assessment (used for the more-stringent alternative) Links to the <u>state-level emissions</u> and Link to the <u>system summary report</u>

#### Additional cost thresholds assessed:

- \$5,000 cost threshold links to the state-level emissions and Link to the system summary report
- \$6,400 cost threshold links to the <u>state-level emissions</u> and Link to the <u>system summary report</u>
- \$10,000 cost threshold links to the state-level emissions and Link to the system summary report
