MINUTES

NACAA BUSINESS MEETING

Tuesday, May 17, 2016

David Klemp (Montana) and Craig Kenworthy (Seattle, WA), Co- Vice Presidents of NACAA, called the Business Meeting to order.

Approval of Minutes

The 2015 Fall Membership Meeting minutes were approved unanimously by both the State Agency and Local Agency Members of NACAA.

NACAA Financial Report

Bill Becker, Executive Director of NACAA, reported on the association's finances, including both federal and non-federal funds. Bill noted that the association is in good financial shape, in part due to additional funding from the Energy Foundation, the Virginia Department of Mines, Minerals, and Energy and the National Association of State Energy Officials. NACAA continues to seek additional outside funding to cover any future funding shortfalls that may occur in order to maintain the smooth operation of the association.

<u>Discussion and Vote on Proposed NACAA Recommendations on the Distribution and Use of VW Settlement Funds</u>

Eddie Terrill (OK), Co-Chair of the NACAA Enforcement and Compliance Committee, led the discussion on NACAA's *Proposed Recommendations on the Distribution of Funds for Environmental Mitigation and Supplemental Environmental Projects Related to Alleged Volkswagen Violations*. Following circulation of, and an opportunity for comment on, a draft of

the documents, the proposed document was distributed to the membership on April 18, 2016 for consideration in preparation for the vote to approve it at the NACAA Business Meeting.

Eddie reported that the NACAA Board of Directors and Committee Chairs, during their meeting on May 15, 2016, had discussed the proposed document and agreed to recommend that the membership approve it. He noted that there was only one change to the version that had been sent to the members on April 18, 2016, and that was the addition of a sentence on page 5, which read, "Additionally, the receipt of funds by a state or local agency under this program should not result in decreases in other funds provided to the agency."

The membership had a brief discussion about the document. Following that, the State Agency Members of NACAA and the Local Agency Members of NACAA, in separate votes, unanimously approved the document.

Other Business

Bill Becker reviewed the schedule for upcoming NACAA meetings:

NACAA 2016 Fall Membership Meeting October 17-19, 2016 in Minneapolis, MN (Loews Minneapolis) (Board of Directors and Committee Chairs Meeting, October 16, 2016)

In addition, the 2017 Spring Membership Meeting will likely be held in Washington. DC.

Bill also noted that in addition to the honors presented at the previous day's lunch (David Shaw (NY) and Barry Stephens (TN) on their recent and upcoming retirements, respectively, and Nancy Kruger (NACAA) for 30 years of service to NACAA) the association had also intended to honor Barry Wallerstein, who recently departed the South Coast Air Quality Management District. However, due to an illness in the family, Barry had to cancel his travel plans.

Bill further announced that at their Sunday meeting, the State Agency Members of the NACAA Board had voted to appoint Steve Flint (NY) to fill the Region 2 Board vacancy left by Dave Shaw, effective immediately, and Dallas Evans (MS) to fill the Region 4 Board vacancy to be left by Barry Stephens, effective July 1, 2016.

The NACAA Business Meeting was adjourned.
