Provide Web Access to the Master SCC List

- Short Term Focus on Point Sources
 - Have the most up-to-date SCC list at a publically-accessible web page or portal on a regular basis
 - Develop/leverage search page
 - Bulk download
 - Other SCC- background information (e.g. SCC history)
 - Create standard web form and auto generate e-mails
 - Questions
 - Requests of SCC creation, edits, or retirement
 - Coordinate with EPA and SLT system owners that use SCCs

Why

- Currently
 - Master SCC table within EIS many cannot access it
 - Several versions of the SCC tables exist confusion
 - No quick and easy way of tracking SCC code changes updates may not be noted
 - Not a transparent process for asking questions or requesting new/editing SCCs
 - Limited use of SCCs in NEI, RTR, and other systems reporting to CEDRI

Why

- Short Term Goal
 - Overcome deficiencies identified
 - Assist users in selecting correct SCCs
 - Reduce reporting errors
 - Reduce post submission corrections
 - Avoid using generic SCCs where an alternative SCC exists

- Provide basics about SCCs
- Contains information about each field
- Easy to use
- Searchable
- Several ways of viewing/downloading/searching
- Provide the ability to ask questions and make requests




- > EPAs public web site

- > Other?


