- Timeline for development

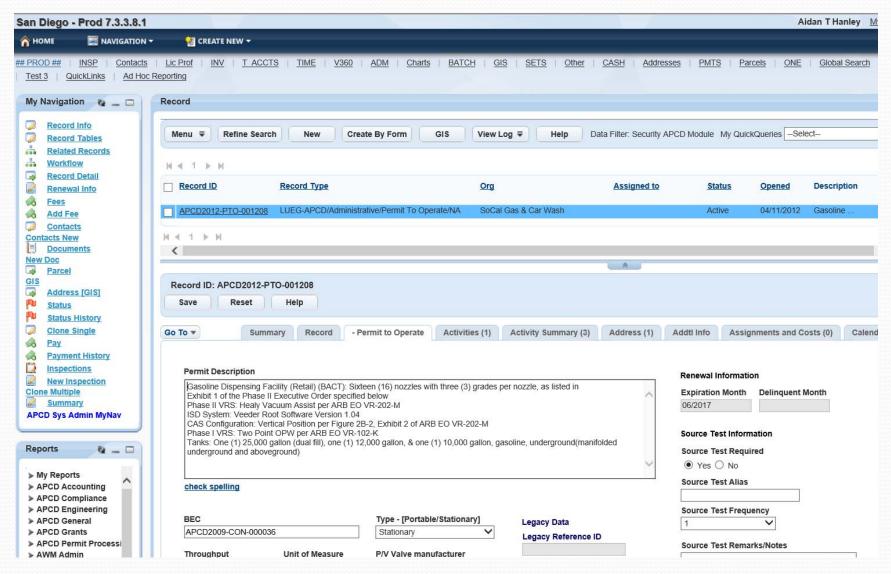


Current Status

 - Title V partially implemented
 - Time accounting and billing
 - Interface with Documentum

 - Inspection E-form (emergency IC engines)

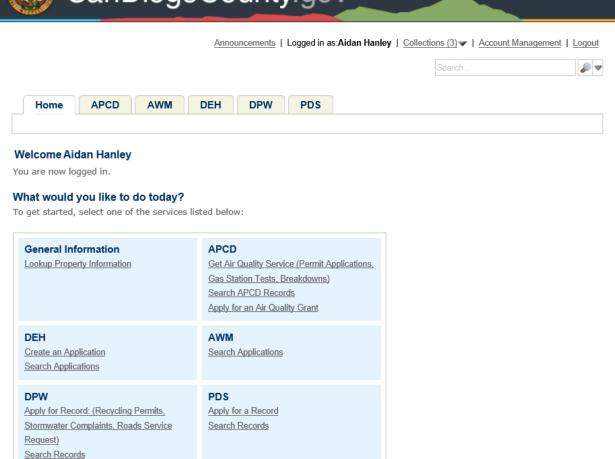


Current Status
