- Methods and Data Review Opportunities
 - By 9/30: NEMO¹ review for VCPs and asphalt paving
 - By 10/10: Agricultural Fertilizer activity review
 - By 10/15: NEMO review for agricultural silage
 - By 12/11: Review/comment on landing and takeoff data (expected release 10/12)
 - By 12/15: Review/comment on animal count data for livestock-related emissions (expected release 10/15)
 - By 12/31: Review draft fires data (expected release 10/8) and voluntary submission of fire activity data; please coordinate with forestry agencies
- Now through 2022: State, local, tribal (SLT) collaboration on emissions methods development provides great value to the process
- Dec. 31, 2021: Reporting deadline to EPA for all nonpoint data (grace period extends until January 15)
- March 30, 2022: Reporting deadline to EPA for nonpoint data category (input templates, survey, emissions)
- Feb/March 2022: Point source review for air toxics (and all pollutants) for Air Toxics Data Update
- April 2022: Final completeness reports sent to Air Directors

Air Emissions Reporting Rule

- EPA is planning to update the AERR for the 2023 or 2024 inventory reporting cycle. Current focuses are:
 - Improving air toxics emissions data
 - Improving emissions data for prescribed fires
 - Improving emissions from intermittent sources (e.g., backup generators)
 - Updating the nonpoint emissions requirements to use current best practices and meet transparency and quality assurance goals
 - Administrative updates
 - Ensure that AERR requirements are consistent with the latest emissions documentation available to data reporting agencies
- Two listening sessions with state/local/tribal agencies were held in April
