GENERAL JOB DUTIES:

Using understanding of industrial processes and equipment, the ES is responsible for development of Title V and ACDPs (Air Contaminant Discharge Permits) for simple to complex sources in assigned source categories. The ES is the primary contact with industry management and environmental operations personnel for matters relating to permit requirements and provisions, air pollution control equipment requirement, and emission limits at plant sites.

QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE REQUIRED:

Bachelor's degree in physical science, environmental science, or closely related field. Two or more years of experience in the field or equivalent education and experience which provides the knowledge, skills, and ability. Three years of experience at a technical or professional level performing activities in a natural resource program such as researching and analyzing data, conducting investigations, applying pertinent laws and regulations, or coordinating and monitoring project activities is preferred. A valid Oregon driver's license is required at time of appointment, depending on area of assignment.
