

Section 112 Update for NACAA

RTR Program Status

- ▶ Finalized RTRs for about 98 source categories to date
- ▶ Court orders for 8 RTRs (deadlines for final rule signature):
 - ▶ Coke Ovens Pushing, Quenching and Battery Stacks RTR required by 12/26/22 (proposal planned for late 2021)
 - ▶ Carbon Black, Cyanide Chemicals, Flexible Foam Fabrication, Mercury Cell Chlor Alkali, and Refractories RTRs required by 11/1/21
 - ▶ Primary Copper RTR required by 4/1/22 (not yet proposed)
 - ▶ Primary Magnesium RTR required by 8/1/22
 - ▶ Two categories, Semiconductors and Spandex, were removed from court order because there are currently no major sources
- ▶ New court-ordered dates established for fixing “gaps” per the *LEAN* Decision for 6 RTRs finalized in summer 2020

Other Upcoming Section 112 Actions

- ▶ Addressing “*LEAN* gaps” in Rubber Tire, Misc. Coating Manufacturing, Lime Manufacturing, Integrated Iron and Steel, Taconite Ore, and Plywood and Composite Wood Products
 - ▶ Court order requires final rules between late 2022 and late 2023
- ▶ Reviewing NESHAP for ethylene oxide and chloroprene emitting source categories
 - ▶ Reviewing commercial sterilizers NESHAP
 - ▶ Negotiating deadline for Hazardous Organics NESHAP (HON)
 - ▶ Planning to review hospital sterilizers, polyether polyols, chemical manufacturing area sources, and neoprene

Other Upcoming Section 112 Actions

- ▶ Evaluating multiple reconsideration requests for various other section 112 rules, including ethylene production, organic liquids distribution, and the miscellaneous organics NESHAP (MON)
- ▶ Evaluating options related to the Mercury and Air Toxics Standards (MATS) for Electric Utilities
- ▶ Completing Boiler MACT remand response

Other Upcoming Section 112 Actions

- ▶ Under consent decree, conducting technology reviews for several major and area source NESHAP, including:
 - ▶ Gasoline Distribution, Subpart R (major)
 - ▶ Gasoline Distribution Bulk Terminals, Subpart BBBBBBB (area)
 - ▶ Dry Cleaning (major and area)
 - ▶ Wood Preserving (area)
 - ▶ Paint Stripping and Miscellaneous Surface Coating (area)
 - ▶ Lead Acid Battery Manufacturing (area)
- ▶ Addition of 1-Bromopropane (1-BP) to the HAP list
 - ▶ Signature of ANPRM expected soon
